# Car Registration Information



All students driving to school in 2023-2024 are required to register their car with the Dean's Office.

**This is true of all students, including those applying for free parking.** All students must complete the

Judge Memorial Parking Application '23-'24 form.

Those who do not register will be ticketed and

fined. **Judge students are visitors to the Douglas**

**neighborhood and should act as such to ensure**

**that the registration system is not terminated.**

# Displaying your Car Registration

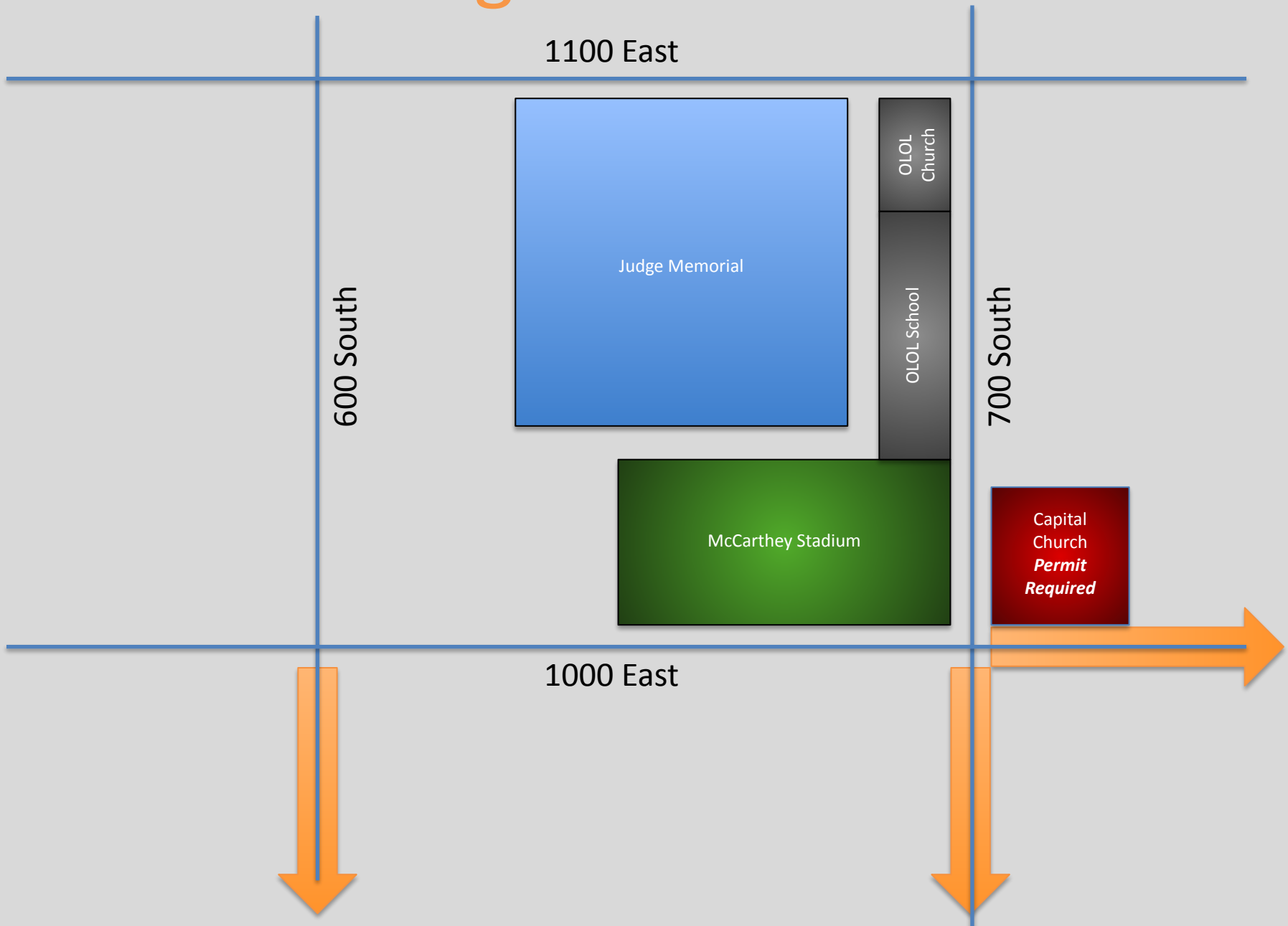


This Car Registration is required for all Judge students parking in the Douglas area. **Students parked in the Douglas area without this registration will be fined.**



Location:  
The car registration must be placed on the driver's side rear window. It **can** be seen through a tinted window

# Student Permit Information

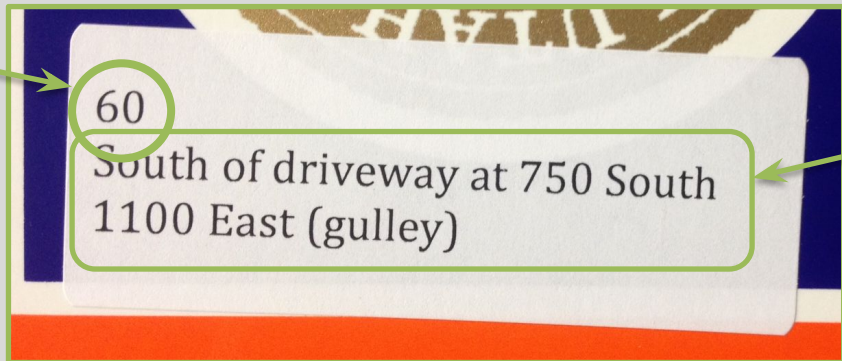
Through an agreement with Salt Lake City and the Douglas Neighborhood, Judge is allowed to offer permitted parking to students through a Student Permit Program. This permit program was negotiated with neighbors and is thoroughly monitored to ensure that we are conscientious visitors. **Judge students are visitors to the Douglas neighborhood and should act as such to ensure that the permit system is not terminated.**

# Reading The Student Permit



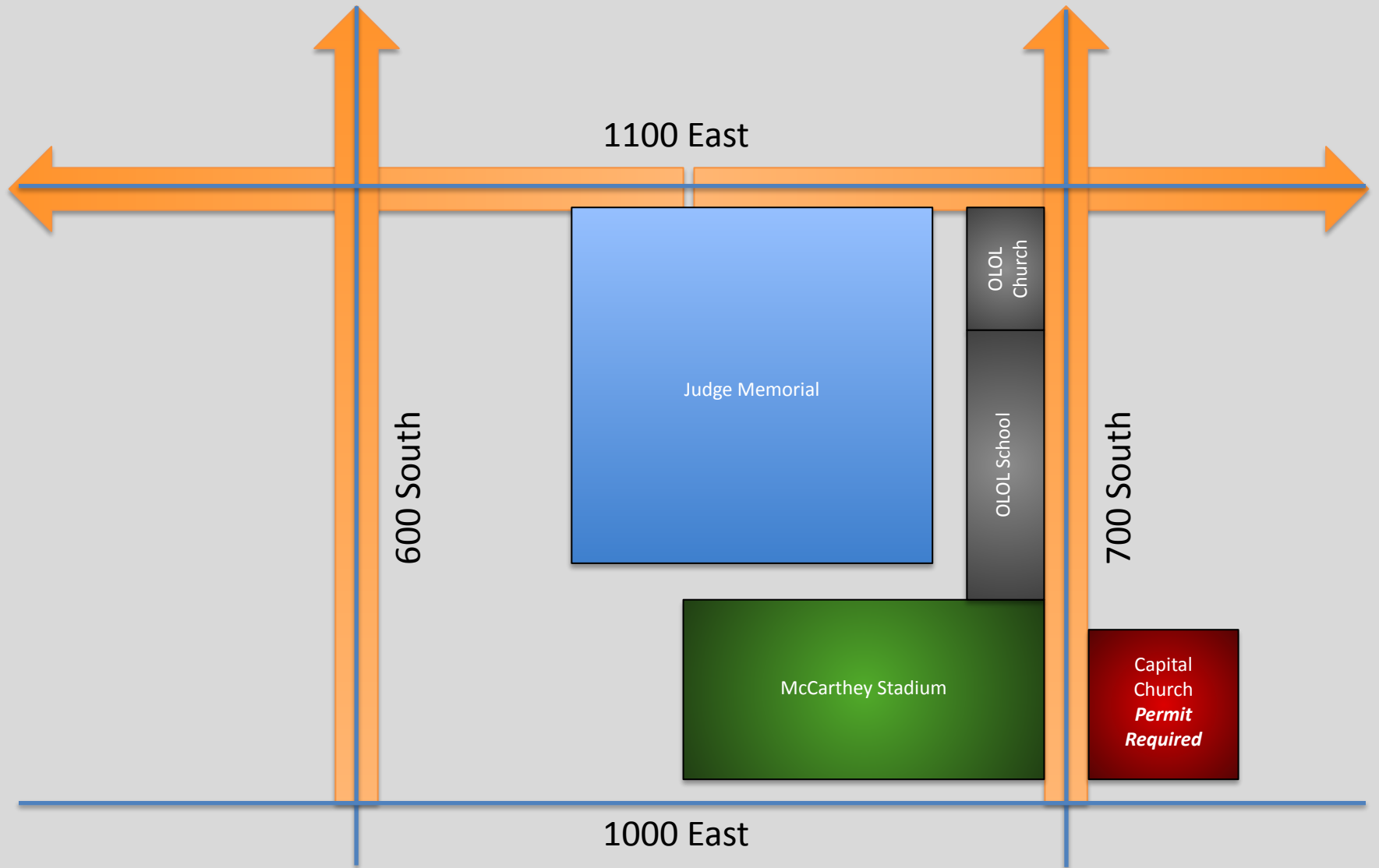
This Student Visitor Permit allows you to park in a Permit Required Zone. It must be displayed, this side up, on your driver's side dash with your Rank/Address Sticker clearly visible.

# “Permit Parking” area shown here



## **Priority parking will be given to applications received:**

- **First, by class and the largest carpool.**
  - Students may only be listed on one carpool, and must not be applying for their own parking permit. One parking permit per family will be assigned.



- **Second, by the date an application is received.**
  - Applications received before August 9th will be assigned a permit of higher rank, while applications received after that date will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis (based on availability of permits).



Parking Permits and Car Registration Stickers will be available for pickup on school days starting August 10th in the Spirit Shop. If you fail to pick up your pass at that time please park in “free parking” until you obtain your pass.



# Reading The Signs

A sign like this indicates a place where your Student Visitor Permit allows you to park, despite a time restricted No Parking Zone.



This tells you that this area is a:  
No Parking Zone  
7AM to 5PM  
Except on  
Saturdays,  
Sundays, And  
Holidays

However, this sign lets you know that with an Area 6 Permit you are exempt from that time restriction, and may park here.

# Reading The Signs

A sign like this indicates a place where you may not park. The Student Visitor Permit does not override this sign.

As indicated on the sign, ***Do Not park to the left of this sign or the city will ticket you.***





# Reading The Signs



No Parking to the Left of this sign, at all, under any circumstance.

OK to park to the Right of this sign with the proper ***Student Permit.***

# Parking On Campus



As students, you are only allowed to park in the Faculty Lots after 3:15 PM, No Earlier. This is not a polite suggestion; this is a requirement..

***This includes Early Out Days;*** on those days the parking lots are still restricted until 3:15 PM.

This parking is the only place allotted to teachers, so when they run a mid-day errand they expect to find their assigned spot open upon their return. After 3:15 PM you are allowed to park in any available numbered stall.

# Parking On Campus



Please note that if you park in the faculty lot this warning will be placed on your car:

*Judge Memorial Catholic High School Faculty Member-*

*This form is a friendly reminder to please park in the parking spot that was assigned to you and please put your parking pass in the front window. If you are receiving this warning, it is a friendly reminder that there is no parking pass in your window.*

***If you are a student, please note that your car has been photographed. Next time you park in the faculty lot your car will be booted; you will pay a \$25.00 fine to have the boot removed; and you will serve a detention.***

# What will earn you a \$25.00 Fine?

- ***Parking in a spot other than the one assigned to you, as indicated by your Permit***
  - If your spot is not available then you need to park in “Free Parking” and notify Coach Pike via email or in person so he can look into it.
- ***Parking in the Faculty Lots:***
  - in an unmarked stall (All Hours)
  - parking before 3:15p, including early out days

## ***No Warnings will be given, each infraction will be fined***

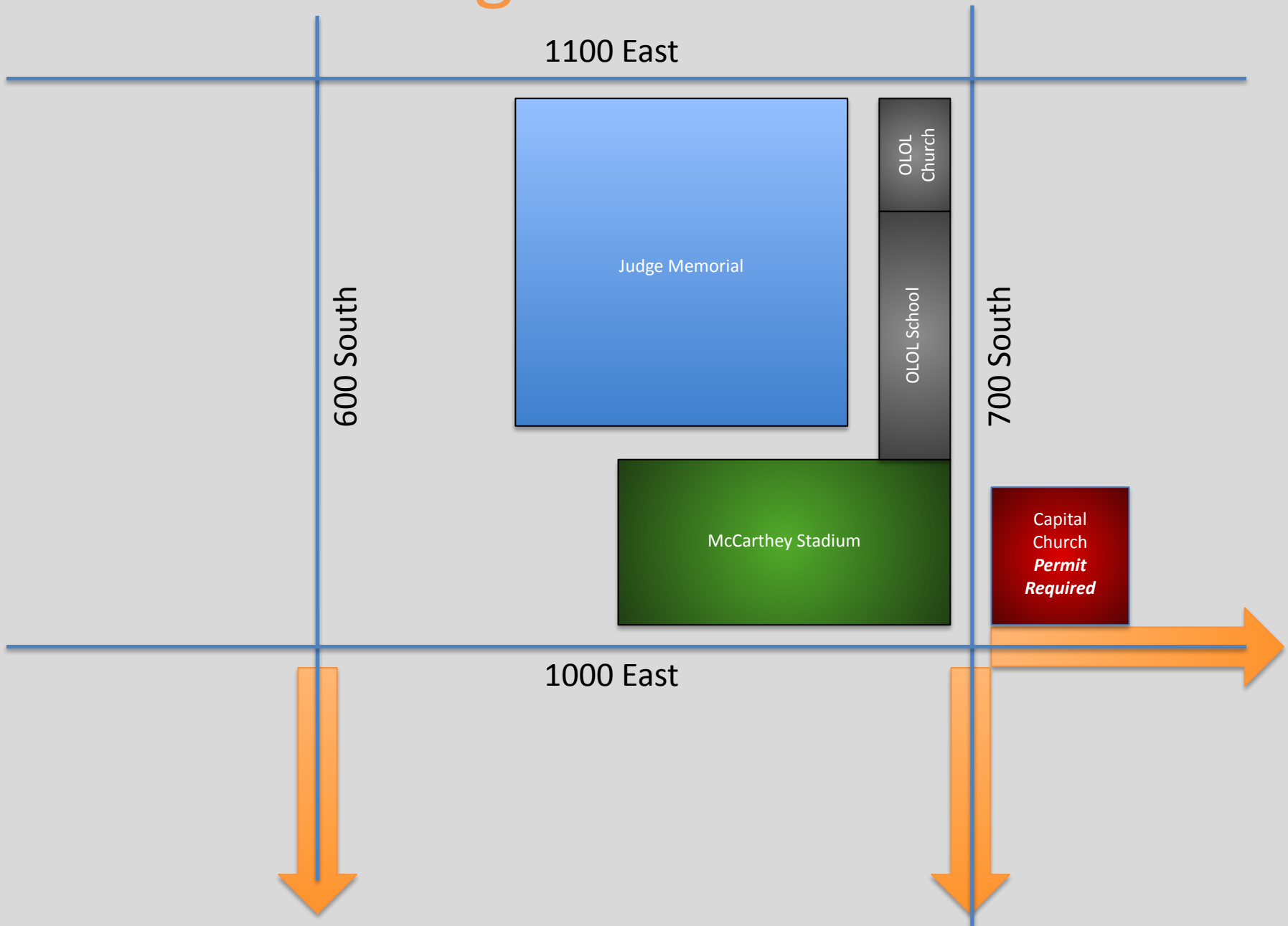
- If you are unclear as to your location speak with Coach Cordova immediately.

- 3 Violations will result in losing your Permit.
  - No Refunds will be given

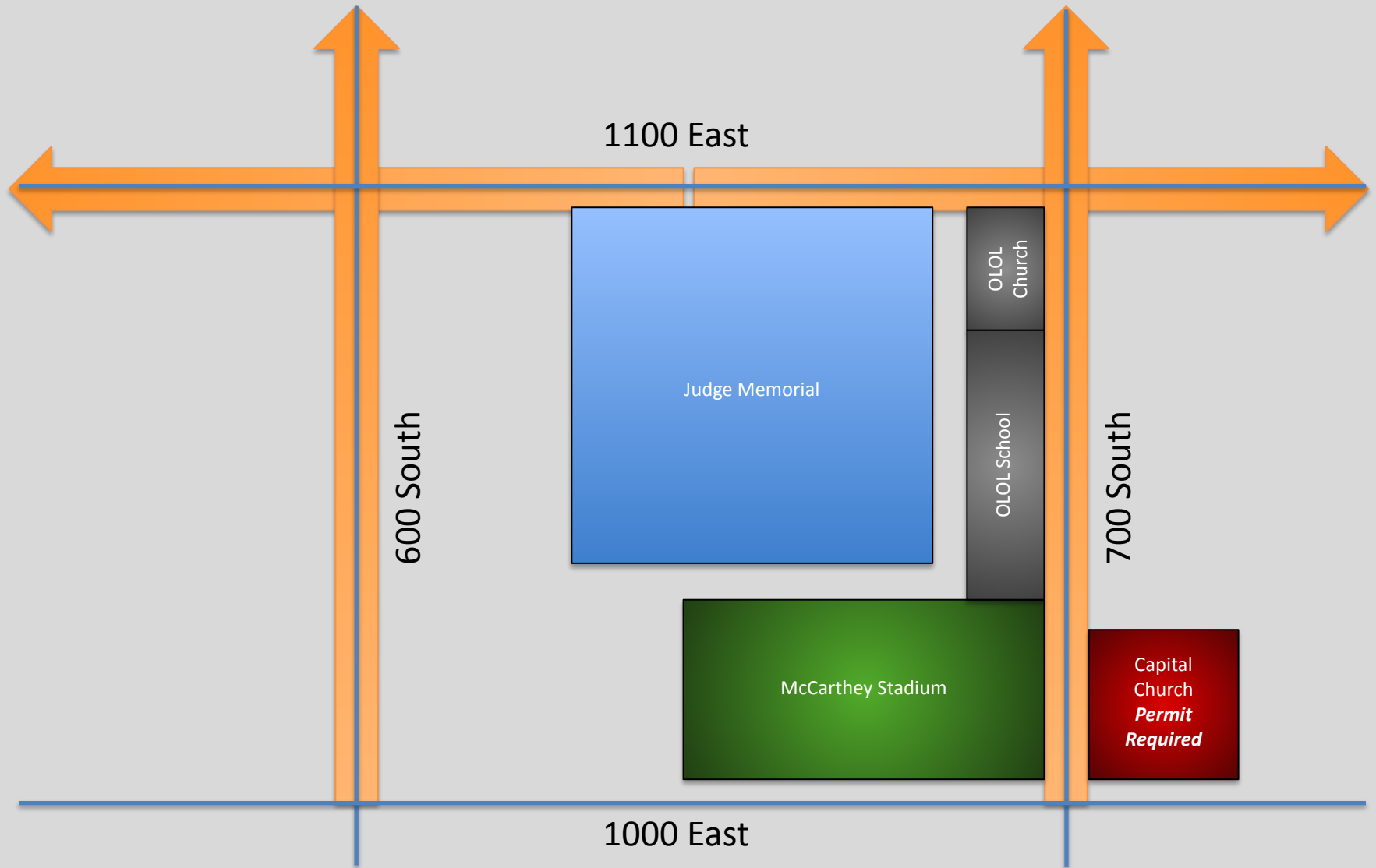


# “Free Parking” area shown below
